RESOLUTION NO. 2025-09-10-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODCREEK,
TEXAS ("CITY"), ESTABLISHING A PARKLAND FUND; UPDATING THE
FUND BALANCE POLICY TO SPECIFY THAT THE CITY WILL TRANSFER
UP TO AND APPROXIMATELY THREE PERCENT (3%) OF THE
UNALLOCATED FUNDS OF THE CITY ANNUALLY TO THE PARKLAND
FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING LAND FOR PARKS AND THE
PRESERVATION OF GREEN SPACES THROUGHOUT AND WITHIN THE
CITY LIMITS**

WHEREAS the City Council has determined there are ongoing concerns regarding the protection of parks and greenspaces within the City of Woodcreek, Texas ("City"); and

WHEREAS parkland and green spaces provide essential ecological, environmental, and health benefits that are integral to the well-being of residents in the city; and

WHEREAS the City Council finds the adoption and establishment of a Parkland Fund, along with updating the City's Fund Balance Policy to specify the annual transfer of up to and approximately three percent (3%) of unallocated funds to the Parkland Fund to purchase land for parks and the preservation of green spaces throughout and within the city limits is necessary for promoting the health, safety, and welfare of the Woodcreek community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODCREEK, THAT:

The Woodcreek Parkland Fund is hereby adopted and established for purposes of promoting purchasing land for parks and the preservation of green spaces throughout and within the city limits.

The City's Fund Balance Policy is hereby amended and updated to specify the annual transfer of up to and approximately three percent (3%) of unallocated funds of the City to the Parkland Fund.

48 The City Council directs City Staff to implement the Parkland Fund and the amendment to
49 update the City's Fund Balance Policy starting October 1, 2025, for the 2025/2026 Fiscal Year
50 and future years for the express purposes set forth herein.
