**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODCREEK,
TEXAS ("CITY"), SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE APPLICATION
TO CHANGE RATES FROM AQUA WATER, INC. AND TO DETERMINE
THE PROPRIETY OF SAME**

WHEREAS the City Council has determined there are ongoing concerns regarding the the Application dated June 18, 2025 to Change Rates received from Aqua Water, Inc. (“Application”); and

WHEREAS the City Council previously decided and took action to suspend the effective date of the changed rates 90 days from July 25, 2025 to October 23, 2025 and began a hearing process to determine the propriety of the Application changed rates requested pursuant to Texas Water Code 13.187(f); and

WHEREAS the City Council finds the need to set a public hearing date to determine the propriety of said Application and to consider the impacts on the health, safety, and welfare of the Woodcreek community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODCREEK, THAT:

I.

The City Council of the City of Woodcreek will set a public hearing to determine the propriety of the Aqua Water, Inc. Application to Change Rates and to consider the impacts on the health, safety, and welfare of the Woodcreek community on November 17, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. to be held at VFW Post #6441, 401 Jacobs Well Rd, Wimberley, TX.

II.

The City Council directs City Staff to post said public hearing pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act and send all necessary notices, including providing notice to Applicant Aqua Water, Inc. and the community.

III.

The City Secretary is instructed to include a copy of this Resolution among the records of the City.
